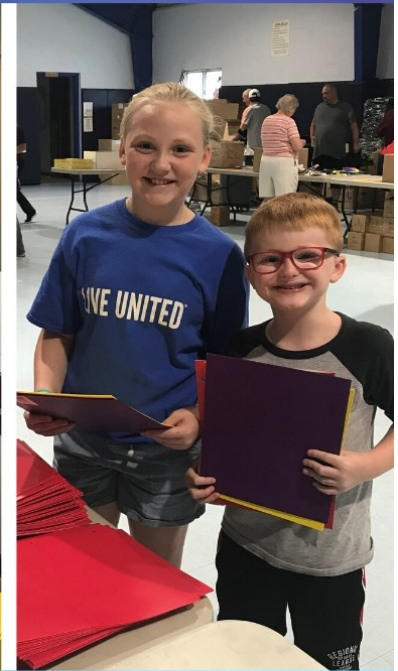

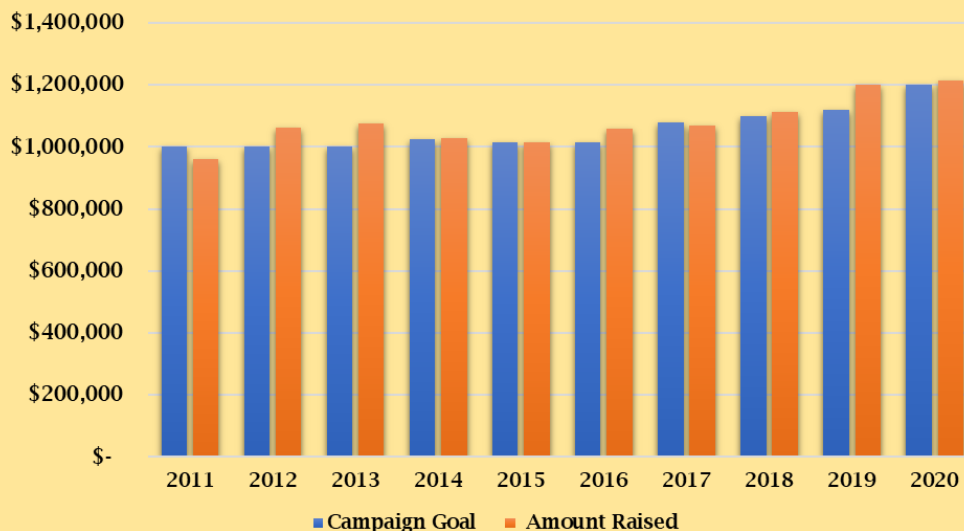

Schuylkill United Way Campaigns



Annual Campaign- All donations are raised from September until November through the generosity of corporate, employee, and individual giving. The campaign helps donors to increase their knowledge of the Schuylkill United Way and to become involved with its 16 partner agencies.

Pacesetters Club—Pacesetters “set the pace” for the Annual Campaign, which officially begins in September. Members of the Pacesetters Club are individuals who contribute a minimum of \$500. For the 2020 Campaign, contributions from the 859 Pacesetters totaled \$614,000. The Co-chairs were Attorney Jay Jones and Patrick Kane.



Captain Jason B. Jones Memorial Day of Caring— Day of Caring is an event to help promote the value of volunteerism, increase the awareness of our human service agencies, and demonstrate what people working together for a common good can accomplish. We volunteer in honor of Captain Jason B. Jones, a Schuylkill County native, who dedicated his life to serving his country and community. On May 10, 2019 we had 832 volunteers who worked hard and gave their time to make a difference! These amazing adults and students logged a total of 2,213 hours of service to our community.



Stuff the Bus—This is a month long school supply drive held each July. Last year, 1,625 backpacks were stuffed with school supplies and distributed to our partner agencies and local schools to be given to children in need throughout Schuylkill County.



Emergency Food & Shelter Program (EFSP) - The Schuylkill United Way serves as the local administrator for the FEMA program which provides funds to supplement and extend current available resources for emergency needs including rent, food, and energy assistance. The money we do receive is distributed to Catholic Charities, Pottsville Salvation Army, Schuylkill Women in Crisis, Schuylkill Community Action, and Servants to All.

Stamp Out Hunger—The second Saturday in May is the largest one-day food drive in the nation. This national effort provides assistance to the millions of Americans struggling to put food on the table. Locally, 31,990 pounds of non-perishable food was collected last year. The Schuylkill United Way is proud to be a partner of this beneficial annual event.



The J.E. Morgan Foundation— The \$75,000 Matching Pacesetters Grant secured a total of \$92,288 from 137 new Pacesetters. The \$50,000 Employee Matching Grant raised a total of \$53,820. The board of directors and our agencies are most appreciative of the generous contribution from the J.E. Morgan Foundation to the SUW Campaign. We are thankful for their continued support.

High School Football Challenge – Six high school football teams participated in this strength and conditioning event on June 25 at Schuylkill Haven High School. From this event we raised \$19,870 through sponsorships, grants, and donations. In addition to raising funds for our 2020 Campaign, we were also able to raise awareness about the Schuylkill United Way and the good that our partner agencies are doing for our county.

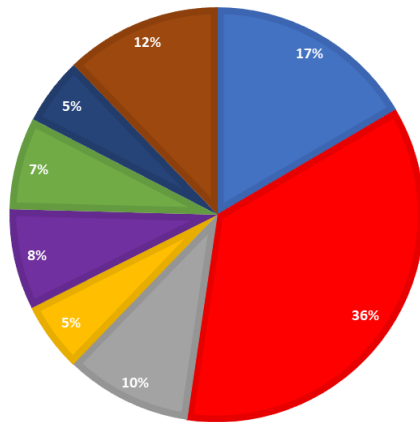
