Because of the support of so many we have been able to help our neighbors in need in the following ways....





To date we have been able to -

*Purchase 3,000 face masks from Kepner Scott Shoe Company for clients of our Partner Agencies

*Provide gift cards for clients of our Partner Agencies to purchase food at Boyer's Food Markets

*Send money to five independently run food pantries

*Provide funding to the Helping Harvest Food Bank of Schuylkill and Berks counties

*Purchase and distribute 3,210 dozen eggs to clients of our Partner Agencies and food pantries

*Purchase face masks, first aid kits, and tissues for Minersville Area "Safe Start to Summer" care packages
