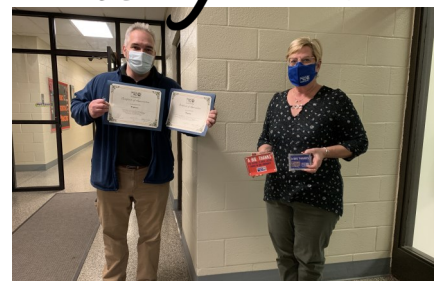

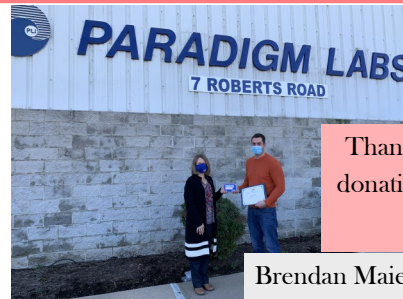

**Annual Campaign**— All donations are raised from September until November through the generosity of corporate, employee, and individual giving. The campaign helps donors to increase their knowledge of the Schuylkill United Way and to become involved with its 15 partner agencies.

**Pacesetters Club**—Pacesetters “set the pace” for the Annual Campaign, which officially begins in September. Members of the Pacesetters Club are individuals who contribute a minimum of \$500. For the 2021 Campaign, contributions from the 804 Pacesetters totaled \$600,000. The Co-chairs were Attorney Jay Jones and Patrick Kane.



**Captain Jason B. Jones Memorial Day of Caring**— Day of Caring is an event to help promote the value of volunteerism, increase the awareness of our human service agencies, and demonstrate what people working together for a common good can accomplish. We volunteer in honor of Captain Jason B. Jones, a Schuylkill County native, who dedicated his life to serving his country and community. On September 11, 2020 we had 120 volunteers who worked hard and gave their time to make a difference!



**Stuff the Bus**—This is a month long school supply drive held each July. Last year, 1,600 backpacks were stuffed with school supplies and distributed to our partner agencies and local schools to be given to children in need throughout Schuylkill County.



**Emergency Food & Shelter Program (EFSP)** - The Schuylkill United Way serves as the local administrator for the FEMA program which provides funds to supplement and extend current available resources for emergency needs including rent, food, and energy assistance. The money we do receive is distributed to Catholic Charities, Pottsville Salvation Army, Schuylkill Women in Crisis, Schuylkill Community Action, Servants to All, Helping Harvest Food Bank, and American Red Cross.



**Stamp Out Hunger**—This food drive was canceled in 2020 but will take place on May 8, 2021.

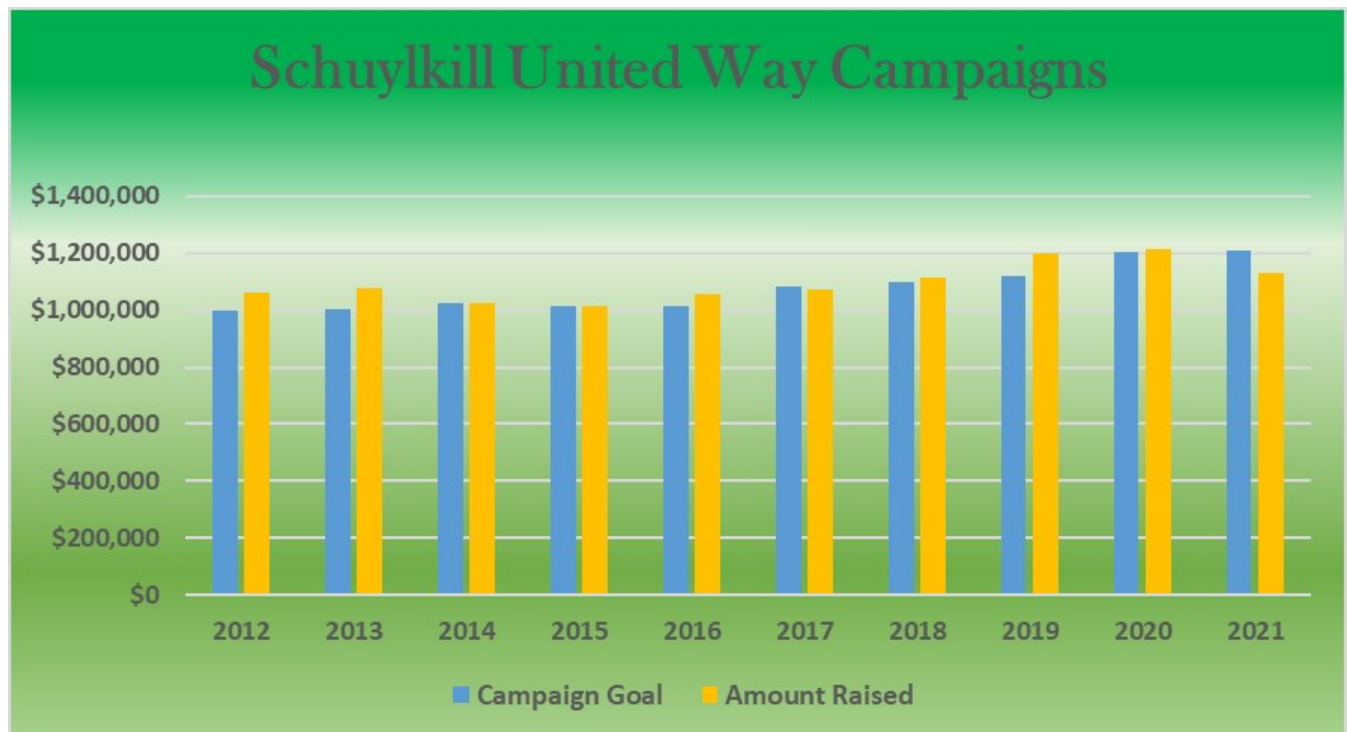

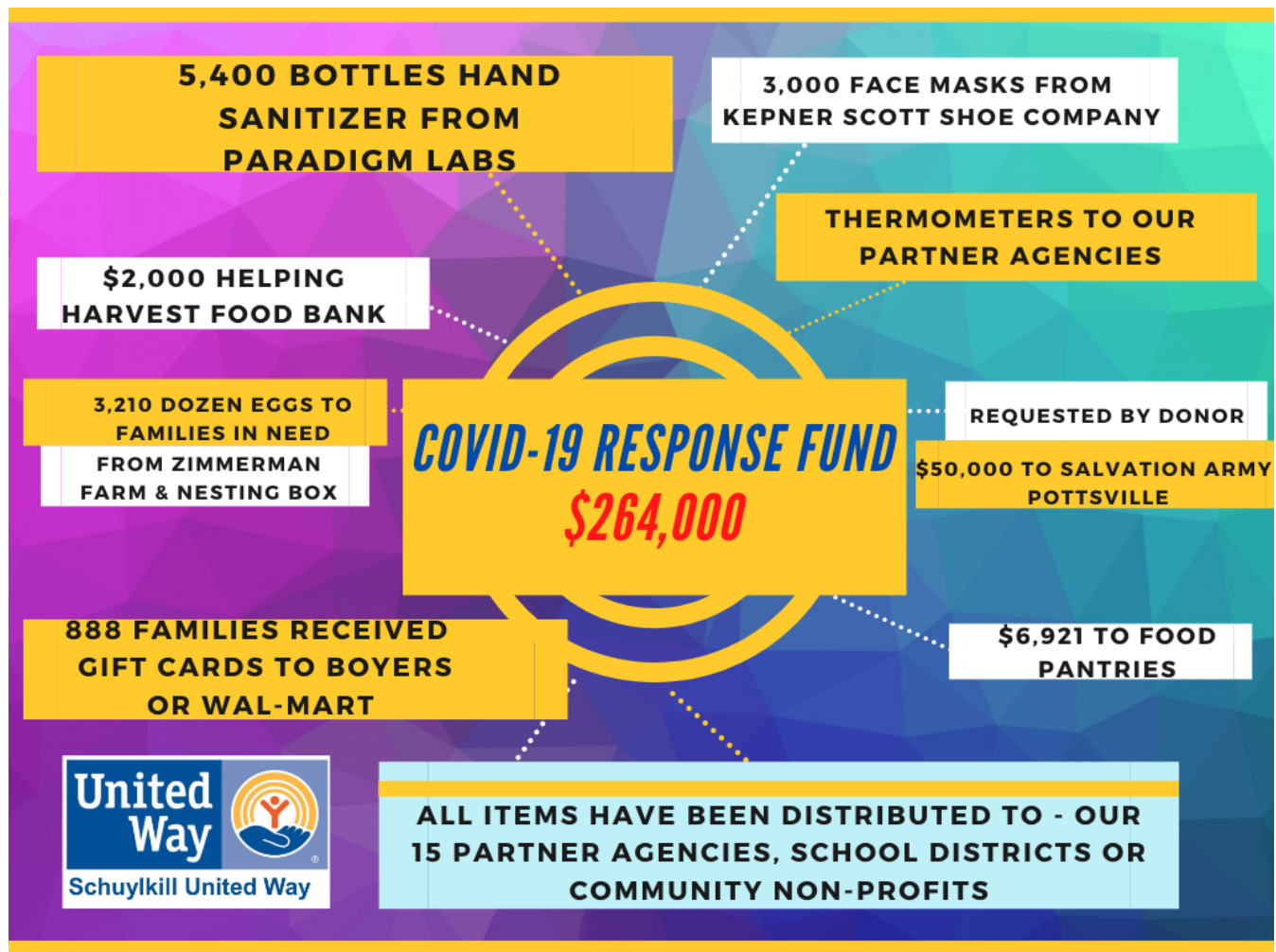
