

Schuylkill Hope Center for Victims of Domestic Violence (formerly known as Schuylkill Women in Crisis) provided emergency safe house services to 123 adults and 76 children totaling 4,129 days in fiscal year 2020/2021.










Thank you to Hydro for hosting a summer golf tournament to benefit the 2022 Campaign. **\$8,052** was raised!
