


HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL CHALLENGE

What does Helping Harvest look like in our county?

*Senior Food Box Program - 340 seniors receive a food box each month at 37 senior housing locations



- *Food Banks, Pantries, Shelters 31 of these agencies receive food regularly from Helping Harvest
- *Weekender Program 12 schools send food home with students to ensure they eat over the weekend
- *Mobile Market Hubs for families and individuals to receive food in Auburn, Girardville, Mahanoy City, Minersville, Pottsville, Shenandoah, & Tamaqua



ST. LUKE'S MINERS CAMPUS COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAM

\$10,000 was awarded to St. Luke's Miners Campus Community Health Program to assist the Tamaqua area with food, clothing, hygiene products, vision assistance, and community events. The overwhelming majority of people served were children.






