- Rules of Eligibility

 2. Drawing order will be as follows: first name wins the 2022 Chevy Trax; second a \$1,500 grocery gift card, third a \$1,000 grocery gift card, fourth a \$750 grocery gift card, fifth a \$500 grocery gift card, sixth a \$250 grocery gift card, seventh name wins the AAA Travel gift certificate; eighth name wins the Lowe's snow blower; ninth name wins the Weber Gas Grill; and tenth name wins the IPAD.
