## 2024 Campaign Goal: \$1,175,000

- Rules of Eligibility
- Prize drawings will be held at the Appreciation Breakfast, Friday Nov. 10, 2023 at 8:30 am. Winners will be notified within 24-hours either by telephone or certified mail. Proper identification is required.
  - Drawing order will be as follows: first name wins the 2023 Ford Escape; second a \$1,500 grocery gift card, third a \$1,000 grocery gift card, fourth a \$750 grocery gift card, fifth a \$500 grocery gift card, sixth a \$250 grocery gift card, seventh name wins the AAA Travel gift certificate; eighth name wins the Lowe's snow blower; ninth name wins the Weber Gas Grill; and tenth name wins the IPAD.
  - All eligible contributions must be completed on Schuylkill United Way entry stubs located on this pledge brochure. Each stub must include name, employer, and telephone number. All stubs must be returned to the Schuylkill United Way office no later than 2 PM on Thursday, November 9, 2023.
  - If a company does not use United Way pledge cards, the company campaign coordinator is responsible for obtaining the proper promotion entry forms from the Schuylkill United Way office.
  - Vehicle selection of the ALL NEW 2023 Ford Escape from Sands Ford of Pottsville will be made in Pottsville. Retail value of \$28,000 will have no cash value. Winners will be required to pay title transfer costs and applicable taxes relating to the new vehicle transaction or any taxes related to the other prizes. The winner must make arrangements for the vehicle no later than December 31, 2023.
